

BACHELOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION IN FINANCE AND RESPONSIBLE INVESTMENT

The aim of the BBA in Finance and Responsible Investment is to offer a theoretical and practical degree that addresses challenges in corporate finance and the broader sustainability agenda for responsible investment.

Learning is acquired through theoretical analysis, practical training, intensive research projects and development of professional and interpersonal skills.

The students will be exposed to real business operations through regular interaction with the business community and corporate world. SUMAS organizes internships in corporations or volunteering work in NGOs. As a result of this work experience a project has to be completed and will constitute the empirical basis for the dissertation work.

During the academic years, the students will develop projects in Switzerland and on abroad in collaboration with academics and practitioners.



PROGRAM LENGTH

3 years divided into 9 terms.

30 core modules including one project management in the field of Business Policy and Strategy. Additionally an intensive research project in Switzerland or abroad, three electives, one work experience (internship) and a selfreflective report, a final dissertation based on empirical research.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Students admitted to undergraduate degree programs are demonstrably qualified for advanced academic study.

- Application form
- Photocopy of a valid passport or ID
- Official Certified Transcripts and Diplomas, with certified translation if not originally in English
- Official Certified Transcript of Bachelor Studies (if applying for transfer of credits)
- CV / Resumé indicating both complete education and any work experience in reverse chronological order
- Motivation Letter indicating why the student chooses Switzerland and why Sustainability Management School
- If you are not a native English speaker, or if you have not spent the last 3 years in an English-taught school: TOEFL (minimum score of 550 PBT or 80 IBT), or IELTS (minimum score of 5.5), or other Standardized English Placement Exams. To submit the TOEFL test score to the Sustainability Management School automatically, please enter SUMAS's TOEFL® Institutional Code number - 4629 when you take the test
