General Conditions

1. Booking

Your registration results in the existence of a contract upon written confirmation from Good Hope Studies.

2. Enty into South Africa

It is your responsibility to provide all required documents when entering South Africa. If entry into the country is denied due to not poviding the required documents, no refunds will be given.

2. Alteration and Cancellation

An alteration fee will be charged for alteration of bookings.

Notice of cancellation before arrival must be made in writing to Good Hope Studies. The deposit is not refundable. For cancellations received within 2 weeks prior to arrival, the cancellation fee amounts to 1 week's tuition and accommodation.

Should any services be cancelled that are not printed on our price list (hotels, flight-tickets, etc.), the cancellation charges of the third party provider will apply.

Tuition fees will be refunded in full if a visa application is rejected or Good Hope Studies is unable to offer the course or a suitable alternative.

3. Withdrawal
