You can send payments to the Centre by cheque, bank draft, or credit/debit card, or your bank can send fees to our bank accounts in London, San Francisco or Vancouver. For payments by credit card we will take payment in your own currency unless you advise us otherwise. The rates used by our UK supplier (Fexco) are guaranteed to be better than those of your card provider.
